

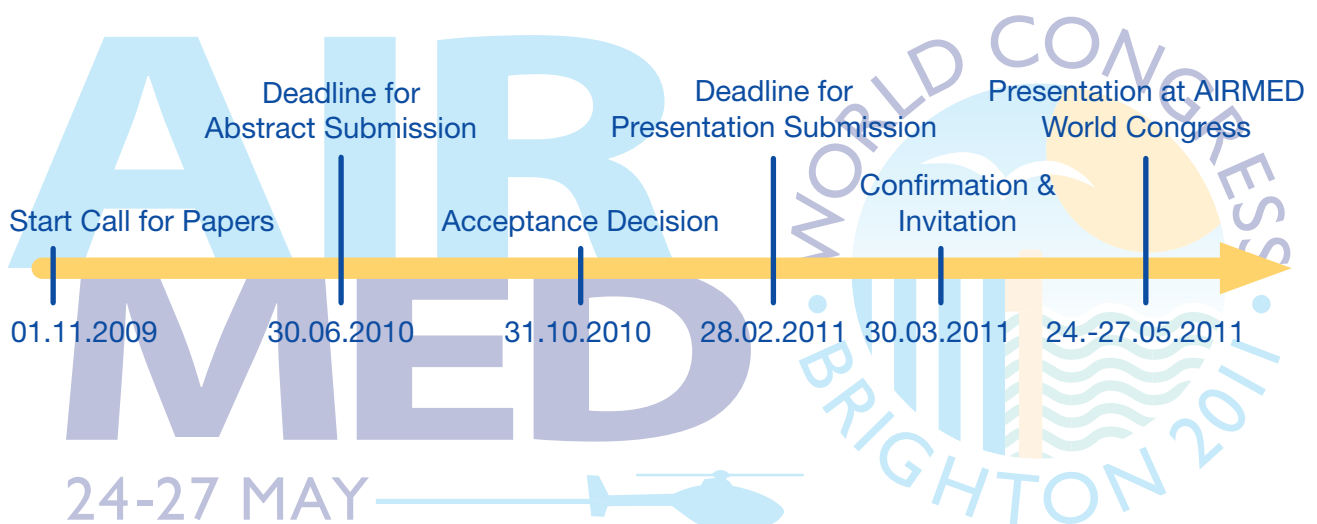
Call for Papers

- Mode of presentation: oral or poster in English

- Lecture max. 10 minutes, followed by 5 minutes for discussions (longer presentations for key note speeches, workshops etc.)
- Presentations: Powerpoint only (no pps files or MAC-version)
- Use of own laptops is not possible
- All authors must agree to EHAC using the presentation with authors being credited
